CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

After any thin set installation of porcelain tile and pavers over concrete, best practices require to perform, after grouting, a first acid deep cleaning.

Failing to follow these instructions could lead to maintenance issues, most of the times derived from grout residues left on the surface of the tiles/pavers which create a film on the tiles/pavers surface itself that tends to retain dirt. If that occurs, the only way to possibly solve the issue is to perform a deep floor cleaning, using acid-based cleaners specific for porcelain and following a specific cleaning procedure described here under. Please note that from time to time, depending on the type (cement-based vs epoxy), quantity and aging of the grout residue left on the tile/pavers surface, it could be really hard or even impossible to fully recover from the problem. That is why Caesar Ceramics highly suggests a first acid deep cleaning right after installing and grouting the tiles/pavers.

FIRST FLOOR DEEP CLEANING AFTER INSTALLATION

After Grouting the Joints it is important to remove the excess grout with a sponge and clear water. After 12/48 hours, the grout in the joints will have “set up” / hardened significantly.

There will be a noticeable residual “haze”. Typically, a diluted acid cleaner specifically for removing “Grout Haze”, combined with a soft scrubbing pad will remove the majority if not all the “Haze”. Change your acid/water solution frequently for best results. It is also recommended to keep a bucket of clean water to remove the acid/water solution. It is recommended to keep and use clean dry towels to help remove as much residual water and keep the floor as dry as possible.

Please refer to the cleaning chemical company’s suggested methods and dilution rates.

For areas with excess grout or grout that becomes adhered to the face of the tile, further cleaning with an Acid/ Water Solution may be necessary. Please refer to the Cleaning Chemical Company’s instructions as not all acids or chemicals are the same. The excess grout residue must be removed so that it does not dry and stick on the surface. It is necessary to change the cleaning water frequently and rinse well.

Attention!! Epoxy-based grout cannot be cleaned when it has completely hardened other than mechanically with risk to the surface of the tiles. For more information and recommendations, consult the grout manufacturer. Care must be taken on inlaid, polished and especially Anti Slip products similar to Aextra20. The use of a floor-washing machine combined with the use of a diluted acid detergent helps reach the spaces between adjacent tiles and clean them properly. If such a cleaning procedure is not carried out, or if such cleaning is carried out too late, the grout residue creates an absorbent film, which holds dirt, making the surface difficult to clean: in this case, Caesar Ceramics will not be liable for any damage caused to the surface.

DAY TO DAY CLEANING

After the post-laying cleaning operation has been thoroughly carried out, as far day to day cleaning we strongly advise against the use of waxes, oily soaps, impregnating products and various treatments (water and oil repellent) on the porcelain stoneware product, as their application is unnecessary. As is often the case in certain off the shelf detergents, they contain waxes and gloss inducing additives which, after various washes, can deposit a bright coat on the floor. Sometimes, even one drop of foods such as Coca Cola, water, wine etc. ...) is sufficient to eliminate this coat, restoring the tile’s original appearance, a stain effect is produced in certain zones. In these cases, the floor must be de-waxed, using products to de-wax the applied waxes, following the producer’s instructions.

For films left by soap, lime scale, dirt, use an acid detergent, suitably diluted in water (read the product instructions carefully). It is also important to point out that Hydrofluoric acid (HF) and its derivatives can irredeemably damage porcelain stoneware. For routine cleaning, Caesar recommends the use of bleach

or ammonia, suitably diluted in water; for polished porcelain stoneware, dry the floor after washing to prevent unsightly smudges.

TIP: Since rinsing well with plenty of clean water is a fundamental part of the day to day cleaning procedure, Caesar advises against the use of products which state that they “do not need rinsing”

EXTRAORDINARY CLEANING

In the case of particular and/or particularly stubborn stains, we recommend using specific detergents as those indicated in chart here under reported. It should furthermore not be forgotten that the removal of any type of stain is easier when the stain is still fresh. It is always important to test the detergents on a small area before applying to the entire surface, particularly in the case of porcelain stoneware with a lapped or polished finish.

FLOOR DEEP CLEANING RECCOMENDATIONS TO BE USED IN CASE OF GROUT RESIDUES LEFT ON TILE /PAVERS SURFACE

1. Preliminary Cleaning Procedure: To begin with, it is important to clean the floor with a traditional detergent (Some examples of suitable detergents you can consider are Deterdek from Fila, Keranet from Mapei) and rinse thoroughly in order to remove any dirt that is present on the tile/pavers aside from the grout left on them. This should be done carefully by following these steps:

- Apply an abundant quantity of detergent to clean the floor, following instructions provided on the detergent’s bottle and making sure that, during the entire cleaning process, the detergent does not get in contact with grass or water of nearby swimming pools (if any)
- Brush strongly to remove the dirt (using a scotch-brite, ideally a motor-brush with scotch brite for big surfaces)
- Rinse well with running water (it is recommend to use a vacuum cleaner to avoid burning the grass)
- Once well rinsed, dry the surface

2. Acidic Cleaning Procedure: Perform the acid cleaning procedure hereunder summarized:

- Apply a professional acidic cleaner for grout haze on the floor. Some examples of suitable acidic cleaners you can consider are DETERDEK from Fila, KERANET from Mapei, or professional acidic cleaners like the one pictured below:
- Apply an abundant quantity of acidic cleaner on the entire floor, following instructions provided on the cleaner’s bottle (for a better result, do not dilute with water), and making sure that, during the entire cleaning process, the cleaner (since it is an acid-based cleaner) does not get in contact with grass or water of nearby swimming pools (if any)
- Once applied, leave the product on the floor for about 20-30 minutes.
- Brush strongly to remove the dirt (using a scotch brite, ideally a motor-brush with scotch brite for big surfaces). It is very important to apply a strong and prolonged mechanical action (tile by tile) on the floor while brushing. Please note that cleaning without a strong mechanical action (e.g. cleaning using a simple mop) is going to be useless and ineffective.
- Rinse the floor, making sure everything is absorbed, so that nothing will get in contact with grass or swimming pool water
- Repeat everything of point “2” as many times as necessary to achieve the desired result.
- Dry the floor’s surface

Additional Notes & Reccomandations

1. Please note that if the grouting was done well before the time of attempted cleaning, the grout residue left on the tile surface would have had time to settle and mature. In this case:

- It is particularly important, during the acid cleaning process, to let the acid settle in on the floor for a few minutes before brushing, so that the acid can soften the grout.

• It is also crucial to brush the tiles using the right tools and to apply on the floor a strong and prolonged mechanical action (tile by tile).

- It is very likely that a single deep acid cleaning will not be sufficient. In this case, it will be necessary to repeat the operation several times in order to eliminate all the grout residues. Keep in mind that the grout residue might not be immediately visible when the floor is clean, but can only be seen when the grout gets dirty. Therefore, even if the floor may appear clean after the first deep cleaning process, it could still have grout residue left on the surface of tile/pavers, that will get visible once they’ll get dirty again. If that is the case, it will be necessary to repeat the deep cleaning procedure more than once until reaching a satisfactory result.
- 2. While performing the deep cleaning process, please be aware of any surrounding grass (making sure that the acid cleaner does not get in contact with it)
- 3. In case a deep cleaning is needed around a pool, make sure that during the entire cleaning process the acid cleaner does not get in contact with the water of the swimming pool
- 4. Never use sealers of any kind on the surface of the porcelain tiles and pavers. Sealers are unnecessary and, furthermore, sealing will change the D.C.O.F. (Dynamic Co-efficient of Friction) of the pavers, resulting in a surface that will become more slippery. Furthermore, since Porcelain has such a low absorption rate, the sealer will unlikely stick and will most likely come off over time.
- 5. Bright colored products, in particular white and extra-white tiles, are very delicate and, although for all intent and purpose

are hygienically clean, However, they can get dirty more easily than darker tiles. It is therefore necessary to remember that these particular products require careful regular maintenance.

Warnings

The above suggestions are a result of research, laboratory tests and several years’ experience. However, the cleaning features of the materials may vary significantly according to the different installation methods, conditions of use, types of surface and destination. As a general rule, the higher the anti-slip values of the tiles are, the greater cleaning inconveniences may arise. The professional operator in charge of maintenance and cleaning shall always check the surface condition before proceeding with any cleaning and/or maintenance operation (we would suggest to test some tiles before installation). Caesar Ceramics declines any liability with reference to cleaning and maintenance operations in case of heavy conditions of use (such as mechanical workshop or spaces presenting oily residues or tire marks), bad installation work or wrong cleaning operations. It is agreed that Caesar Ceramics shall not be liable for any event, damage or defect due to wrong installation of the tiles, faulty cleaning and maintenance operations or inadequate choice of the type of material to be laid or of the adhesives used in a certain destination of use.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE

In these Terms and Conditions of Sale, Caesar Ceramics USA, Inc., is referred to as "Caesar", and the customer or person or entity purchasing Caesar's products (herein referred to as "Products" and "Goods") from Caesar is referred to as the "Buyer".

These Terms and Conditions of Sale, and Caesar's Order confirmation constitute the complete and exclusive agreement and understanding governing the sale of Goods by Caesar to Buyer (the "Agreement") and supersede all prior agreements, understandings or representations, whether written or oral, among the parties with respect to such matters. Provided, however, that if any term, provision or condition of Caesar's Order confirmation should conflict or be inconsistent with any paragraph of these Terms and Conditions, then the content of Caesar's Order confirmation shall prevail and control over such conflicting and/or inconsistent terms.

BY ACCEPTING CAESAR'S ORDER CONFIRMATION AND/OR BY ACCEPTING SHIPMENT OF PRODUCTS, BUYER ACKNOWLEDGES, ACCEPTS, AND AGREES TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

Caesar reserves, in its sole discretion, the right to refuse any order. No order is accepted by Caesar until: (i) Caesar provides Buyer with a written Order confirmation, and (ii) Buyer duly signs the Order confirmation in acknowledgement, acceptance and agreement, and returns the signed Order Acknowledgement to Caesar.

1. PRICES: All prices for Goods, including, but not limited to, those specified in Caesar's price list or schedule, website or written quotation, are subject to change without notice. Such prices shall be automatically adjusted to reflect Caesar's prices of Products as in effect at the time of the requested shipment date, and each shipment will be invoiced at such adjusted prices. Unless otherwise expressly agreed by Caesar in writing, all prices are EX WORKS (which shall have the same meaning as in the Incoterms 2020 published by the International Chamber of Commerce), exclusive of any applicable taxes, duties, sales taxes, transportation and insurance costs or charges (collectively "Charges"), which are to be borne exclusively by Buyer.

2. TERMS OF PAYMENT: Unless otherwise expressly agreed by Caesar in writing in Caesar's Order confirmation, the purchase price for all orders shall be paid in full in advance of shipment. All payments must be made in U.S. currency. In the event Buyer fails to make any payment when due, Caesar shall have the right, in addition to all other remedies available to Caesar either at law or in equity, to either terminate this Agreement immediately, without notice, or to suspend further performance under this Agreement. Buyer shall be liable for all expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, relating to the collection of past due amounts. If any payment owed to Caesar is not paid when due, it shall accrue interest at the rate of the lesser of 15% per annum, or the maximum amount permitted by applicable law, from the date on which such past due amount is due until the past due amount is paid in full. Should Buyer's financial responsibility become unsatisfactory to Caesar, cash payments or security satisfactory to Caesar may be required by Caesar for future deliveries and for the Goods theretofore delivered. If such cash payment or security is not provided, in addition to Caesar's other rights and remedies, Caesar may discontinue deliveries.

3. SHIPMENT AND DELIVERY: a) Unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing by Caesar, shipments are made EX WORKS (which shall have the same meaning as in the Incoterms 2020 published by the International Chamber of Commerce). Responsibility for, and any risk of loss or damage to, the Products shall pass from Caesar to Buyer upon delivery of the Products to carrier. Any claims for shortages or damages suffered in transit are under the responsibility of Buyer and shall be submitted by Buyer directly to the carrier. Shortages or damages must be acknowledged and signed for at the time of delivery. Buyer affirmatively waives any claim for damage not acknowledged at the time of delivery. While Caesar will use all reasonable commercial efforts to maintain the delivery date(s) acknowledged or quoted by Caesar, all shipping dates are approximate and not guaranteed. Caesar reserves the right to make partial shipments. Caesar, at its option, shall not be bound to tender delivery of any Goods for which Buyer has not provided accurate shipping instructions. If the shipment of the Products is postponed or delayed by Buyer for any reason including, but not limited to, Buyer providing Caesar with inaccurate shipping instructions, then Buyer agrees to reimburse Caesar for any and all transport and/or storage costs and other additional and incidental expenses resulting therefrom.

4. CLAIM ON TRANSPORTATION (if applicable): In instances in which shipment is made FCA or CPT (which shall have the same meaning as in the Incoterms 2020

published by the International Chamber of Commerce) all Products must be inspected at time of arrival for visible damages and Buyer must note on the Proof of Delivery "POD" any damages prior to the delivery driver departing. Failure to note damage on the POD shall result in a waiver of any claim related to damaged Goods. If Buyer discovers concealed damages or shortages after the delivery driver has left Buyer's premises and those damages or shortages have not been clearly specified on the POD, Buyer is required to notify Caesar's Customer Service care department within three (3) days of the delivery in writing by e-mail to customercare@caesarceramicsusa.com, including a thorough explanation as to why the damage could not have been seen at the time of delivery.

Buyer's claim must include all of the following information:

- Company name
- Address where the shipment was delivered
- Delivery date
- Name of the carrier
- Order #
- Delivery #
- Description of the damage
- Quantification of the damage (how many boxes, tiles, etc.)
- Pictures of the damaged material

Upon receipt of the claim, Caesar will initiate a claim with the carrier. Caesar shall not be responsible for any reimbursement or replacement decision made by the carrier under any circumstance. Caesar cannot assure that the claim will be approved by the carrier. Damaged material subject to any claim should not be returned to Caesar without Caesar's written prior approval and it should not be disposed of or further altered in anyway. Any allegedly damaged Goods should be clearly marked as nonconforming and stored safely until the claim is fully resolved. In the event the claim is denied by the carrier, Caesar reserves the right to also deny the claim and request payment of the corresponding invoice without deductions. Caesar is under no obligation to replace Goods that were damaged as a result of the carrier.

5. LIMITED WARRANTY: a) Subject to the limitations set forth in Section 6 below, Caesar warrants that Products sold by Caesar as "first choice goods" are manufactured in accordance with Caesar's published technical standards. This limited warranty is valid only: (i) for a period of one hundred and eighty (180) days from the date of shipment of the Goods by Caesar, or (ii) for the period from the date of shipment of the Goods by Caesar until installation or attempted installation of the Goods, whichever is less. This limited warranty applies only to "first choice goods" sold by Caesar. ALL GOODS SOLD BY CAESAR OTHER THAN "FIRST CHOICE PRODUCTS" ARE SOLD AS IS. THIS IS THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE WARRANTY GIVEN BY CAESAR WITH RESPECT TO THE GOODS AND IS IN LIEU OF AND EXCLUDES ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, ARISING BY OPERATION OF LAW OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE WHETHER OR NOT THE PURPOSE OR USE HAS BEEN DISCLOSED TO CAESAR, AND WHETHER OR NOT CAESAR'S PRODUCTS ARE SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED AND/OR MANUFACTURED BY CAESAR FOR BUYER'S (OR ANY SUBSEQUENT TRANSFEREE'S, AS DEFINED BELOW) USE OR PURPOSE.

OTHER THAN REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES MADE BY CAESAR IN ITS LITERATURE AND/OR PACKAGING, NO REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY OF ANY KIND REGARDING THE PRODUCTS MADE BY ANY PERSON OR ENTITY INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, INDEPENDENT DISTRIBUTORS AND SALES REPRESENTATIVES, SHALL BE BINDING UPON CAESAR.

IF YOU ARE A CONSUMER, AND SHOULD ANY APPLICABLE LAW PROHIBIT THE DISCLAIMER OF IMPLIED WARRANTIES SET FORTH ABOVE, THEN ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES FOUND TO EXIST WILL BE STRICTLY LIMITED TO THE DURATION OF THE LIMITED WARRANTY SET FORTH ABOVE.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, this limited warranty does not extend to any losses or damages due to misuse, accident, abuse, neglect, normal wear and tear, negligence (other than Caesar's), unauthorized modification or alteration, use beyond rate capacity, or improper installation, maintenance or application. To the extent that Buyer and/or its agents have supplied specifications, information, representation of operating conditions, or other data to Caesar or Manufacturer in the selection or design of the Goods and the preparation of Caesar's quotation, and in the event that actual operating conditions or other conditions differ from those represented by Buyer, any warranties or other provisions contained herein which are affected by such conditions shall be null and void.

TILE BY ITS NATURE AND DUE TO THE VARIABILITY OF THE NATURAL MATERIAL AND PRODUCTION PROCESS ITSELF IS A MATERIAL SUBJECT TO VARIATION IN COLOR AND/OR VEINING AS WELL AS TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO DCOF (DYNAMIC COEFFICIENT OF FRICTION). EXPRESS TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS ARE NOT GUARANTEES OF MINIMUM OR MAXIMUM THRESHOLDS OF PERFORMANCE.

CAESAR DOES NOT WARRANT THAT OUR PORCELAIN TILES WILL NOT SCRATCH, CHIP OR SHOW SIGNS OF WEAR.

Buyer must notify Caesar of any defects in the Products in writing, via certified mail to Caesar Ceramics USA, at 500, Wilson Pike Circle, Ste 127, Brentwood - TN, 37027 - 3261, within thirty (30) days of Buyer's receipt of the Goods. Failure to provide such notice within 30 days of receipt shall act as a complete bar to any claims against Caesar for any defect. Upon receiving Buyer's notice of defect, Caesar shall, at its option, repair, correct or replace the Goods EX WORKS (which shall have the same meaning as in the Incoterms 2020 published by the International Chamber of Commerce), or refund the purchase price for that portion of the Products found by Caesar to be defective. Failure by Buyer to give such written notice within the applicable time period shall be deemed an absolute and unconditional waiver of Buyer's claim for such defects. Goods repaired or replaced during the warranty period shall be covered by the foregoing warranty for the remainder of the original warranty period or ninety (90) days from the date of shipment, whichever is longer. Notwithstanding the provisions contained in the preceding sentences of this paragraph, Buyer shall be deemed to have accepted the Products and absolutely and unconditionally waived its rights to claim for any defects: (i) upon installation or attempted installation of the Products, or (ii) if the Products are otherwise used or altered in any way. It is Buyer's obligation to fully inspect the Goods prior to installation or attempted installation.

Buyer assumes all other responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to persons or property arising out of, connected with, or resulting from the use of Goods, either alone or in combination with other products/components.

This Section 5 also applies in the event that any entity or person (other than Buyer) buys, acquires or uses the Goods, including, but not limited to, any entity or person who obtains the Products from Buyer (any of them a "Subsequent Transferee"). Buyer hereby covenants and agrees to provide such Subsequent Transferee with written notice of the provisions set forth in Sections 5 and 6 of these Terms and Conditions of Sale, by providing each such Subsequent Transferee with a copy of these Terms and Conditions of Sale, or an online link thereto, at the time of sale from the Buyer to the Subsequent Transferee. Additionally, should a Subsequent Transferee again transfer or sell the Goods to another end user, the Subsequent Transferee shall be under the same obligation to provide notice of these Terms and Conditions of sale to the end user. Buyer, furthermore, covenants and agrees that it shall not make any representation or warranty whatsoever regarding the Products to any third party (either on behalf of Caesar or on its own account), other than the limited warranty of Caesar set forth in this Section 5. BUYER HEREBY COVENANTS AND AGREES THAT, SHOULD IT FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH, BUYER SHALL DEFEND, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD LANDMARK, ITS OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, AND AGENTS HARMLESS FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, LOSS, EXPENSE (INCLUDING REASONABLE ATTORNEYS' FEES), OR CLAIMS FOR INJURY OR DAMAGES (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO GENERAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL AND PUNITIVE DAMAGES) ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH BUYER'S OR BUYER'S EMPLOYEES', AGENTS', REPRESENTATIVES' AND/OR INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS' BREACH OF THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE. For clarity, this Section shall control and supersede any state law providing for any indemnification to Buyer by Landmark for any claims raised by a Subsequent Transferee where Buyer has failed to comply with this Section.1

6. LIMITATION OF REMEDY AND LIABILITY: THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDY FOR BREACH OF ANY WARRANTY HEREUNDER SHALL BE LIMITED TO REPAIR, CORRECTION OR REPLACEMENT, OR REFUND OF THE PURCHASE PRICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 5 ABOVE. BUYER, ANY SUBSEQUENT TRANSFEREE, AND ANY END USER OF THE GOODS AGREE THAT CAESAR SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR DAMAGES CAUSED BY DELAY IN PERFORMANCE AND, IN NO EVENT, REGARDLESS OF THE FORM OF THE CLAIM OR CAUSE OF ACTION (WHETHER BASED IN CONTRACT,

INFRINGEMENT, NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY, INDEMNIFICATION, OTHER TORT, OR OTHERWISE), SHALL CAESAR'S LIABILITY TO BUYER AND/OR ANY SUBSEQUENT TRANSFEREES EXCEED THE PRICE PAID BY BUYER FOR THE SPECIFIC GOODS PROVIDED BY CAESAR GIVING RISE TO THE CLAIM OR CAUSE OF ACTION. THIS INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, ANY CLAIM BY BUYER, A SUBSEQUENT TRANSFEREE, OR AN END USER OF THE GOODS FOR INDEMNIFICATION OR ATTORNEYS' FEES IN EXCESS OF THE PURCHASE PRICE BY BUYER, AND SHALL SUPERSEDE ANY STATE LAW TO THE CONTRARY. BUYER AND ANY SUBSEQUENT TRANSFEREE AGREES THAT IN NO EVENT SHALL CAESAR'S OR MANUFACTURER'S LIABILITY TO BUYER AND/OR ANY SUBSEQUENT TRANSFEREES EXTEND TO INCLUDE INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES. The term "consequential damages" shall include, but not be limited to, loss of anticipated profits, loss of business opportunity, business interruption, loss of use or revenue, cost of capital or loss or damage to property or equipment.

7. EXCUSE OF PERFORMANCE: Neither Caesar nor Manufacturer shall be liable for delays in performance or for non-performance due to: acts of God; acts of Buyer; war; fire; flood; weather; sabotage; strikes or labor disputes; civil disturbances or riots; governmental requests, restrictions, allocations, laws, regulations, orders or actions; unavailability of or delays in transportation; pandemic or epidemic; default of suppliers; material fluctuations in the exchange rate between the U.S. Dollar and Euro; or unforeseen circumstances or any events or causes beyond Caesar's or Manufacturer's reasonable control. Deliveries or other performance may be suspended for an appropriate period of time or canceled by Caesar upon notice to Buyer in the event of any of the foregoing, but the balance of the Agreement shall otherwise remain unaffected as a result of the foregoing.

If Caesar determines that its ability to supply the total demand for the Goods, or to obtain material used directly or indirectly in the manufacture of the Goods, is hindered, limited or made impracticable due to causes set forth in the preceding paragraph, Caesar may allocate its available supply of the Goods or such material (without obligation to acquire other supplies of any such Goods or material) among its purchasers on such basis as Caesar determines to be equitable without liability for any failure of performance which may result therefrom.

8. CANCELLATION: Buyer may cancel orders only upon reasonable advance written notice and upon payment to Caesar of Caesar's cancellation charges which include, among other things, all costs and expenses incurred, and to cover commitments made by Caesar or Manufacturer and a reasonable profit thereon, both for Standard Products (those appearing in Caesar's Catalog) and Custom or Made on Order Products (which means Products manufactured upon request of the Buyer, not included in the current Caesar's Pricelist, or Products declared as "made on Order" according to the current Caesar's Pricelist).

Caesar's determination of such cancellation charges shall be conclusive. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT ANY CANCELLATION MUST BE MADE BEFORE THE GOODS HAVE BEEN SHIPPED.

9. CHANGES OR ADDITIONS TO ORDER: Buyer may request changes or additions to the Goods consistent with Caesar's specifications and criteria. Caesar is not obligated, however, to accept any changes or additions. In the event such changes or additions are accepted by Caesar, Caesar may revise the price and dates of delivery accordingly. Caesar reserves the right to make technical and manufacturing changes to the Product(s), none of which will substantially alter the aesthetic of the Product(s), without prior notice to Buyer, except with respect to Product(s) being made-to-order for Buyer.

10. RETURNED GOODS: Except as otherwise provided in Section 5 above with respect to warranty defects, any and all material which Buyer desires to return and which Caesar agrees to take back will be accepted only with prior written authorization and must be in full compliance of this return policy. Caesar is under no obligation to accept a return, and returns will be accepted in its sole discretion. No returns will be accepted for discontinued material and for products other than first choice products. Returns will not be accepted unless Caesar has first issued a Return Authorization Number. Only Caesar's Customer Service Department can authorize a return, and all return authorizations must be in writing. No sales representative may accept the return of any products without such written authorization. Products may be returned to Caesar only after inspection by Caesar and after receipt by the Buyer of shipping instructions. Returns will be charged a minimum of 25% restocking fee (unless Caesar erred in filling the order) and will be limited to full and unopened cartons that have not been

damaged or mutilated in any way. Shipping, handling, insurance, taxes, risk of loss and tariff charges for return products shall be borne by the Buyer.

11. INDEMNIFICATION: Buyer hereby covenants and agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless Caesar, Manufacturer, their officers, directors, employees, agents, advisers, representatives and affiliates (collectively, the "Indemnitees") from and against, and pay or reimburse the Indemnitees for any and all claims, liabilities, obligations, losses, fines, costs, royalties, proceedings, deficiencies or damages (whether absolute, accrued, conditional or otherwise and whether or not resulting from third party claims), including out-of-pocket expenses and reasonable attorneys' and accountants' fees incurred in the investigation or defense of any of the same or in asserting any of their respective rights hereunder (collectively, "Losses"), resulting from or arising out of: (i) Buyer's breach of any provision or covenant set forth in this Agreement, and/or (ii) Buyer's making of any representation to any third party regarding the Goods other than the limited warranty set forth in Section 4 above.

12. ASSIGNMENT: Buyer shall not assign its rights or delegate its duties hereunder or any interest herein without the prior written consent of Caesar, and any such assignment, without such consent, shall be void.

13. GENERAL PROVISIONS: No change, modification, rescission, discharge, abandonment, or waiver of these Terms and Conditions of Sale shall be binding upon Caesar or Manufacturer unless made in writing and signed on its behalf by a duly authorized representative of Caesar or Manufacturer. No conditions, usage of trade, course of dealing or performance, understanding or agreement purporting to modify, vary, explain, or supplement these Terms and Conditions of Sale shall be binding unless hereafter made in writing and signed by the party to be bound, and no modification or additional terms shall be applicable to this Agreement by Caesar's receipt, acknowledgment, or acceptance of purchase orders, shipping instruction forms, or other documentation containing terms at variance with or in addition to those set forth herein. No waiver by either party with respect to any breach or default or of any right or remedy, and no course of dealing, shall be deemed to constitute a continuing waiver of any other breach or default or of any other right or remedy, unless such waiver be expressed in writing and signed by the party to be bound. All typographical or clerical errors made by Caesar in any quotation, acknowledgment or publication are subject to correction.

14. SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this Agreement shall be held invalid or unenforceable by competent authority, such provision shall be construed so as to be limited or reduced to be enforceable to the maximum extent compatible with the law as it shall then appear. The total invalidity or unenforceability of any particular provision of this Agreement shall not affect the other provisions hereof and this Agreement shall be construed in all respects as if such invalid or unenforceable provision were omitted.

15. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION: This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Tennessee without reference to its conflicts of laws principles. Buyer, Caesar and Manufacturer, and any Subsequent Transferee agree to submit all disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement to the exclusive jurisdiction of the State and Federal courts of the State of Tennessee, located in Davidson County. EACH PARTY TO THIS AGREEMENT ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT ANY CONTROVERSY WHICH MAY ARISE UNDER THIS AGREEMENT IS LIKELY TO INVOLVE COMPLICATED AND DIFFICULT ISSUES, AND, THEREFORE, EACH SUCH PARTY HEREBY IRREVOCABLY AND UNCONDITIONALLY WAIVES ANY RIGHT SUCH PARTY MAY HAVE TO A TRIAL BY JURY IN RESPECT OF ANY LITIGATION DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT, OR THE BREACH, TERMINATION OR VALIDITY OF THIS AGREEMENT, OR THE TRANSACTIONS CONTEMPLATED BY THIS AGREEMENT. EACH SUCH PARTY CERTIFIES THAT THEY HAVE NOT RELIED UPON ANY REPRESENTATION OR INDUCEMENT OF THE OTHER PARTY IN AGREEING TO THIS PROVISION AND THAT THEY FREELY, KNOWINGLY AND VOLUNTARILY WAIVE THEIR RIGHT TO A JURY TRIAL. The Convention for the International Sale of Goods shall not apply to this Agreement.

16. U.S. EXPORT CONTROL REGULATIONS: All Goods sold to Buyer are subject to the export control laws of the United States and Buyer agrees not to re-sell or divert any Goods contrary to such laws.

17. NO THIRD PARTY RIGHTS: These Terms and Conditions of Sale create no third party rights between Caesar and any person other than Buyer, including

but not limited to any Subsequent Transferee. It is understood and agreed that the parties do not intend that any third party be a beneficiary of these Terms and Conditions of Sale.

18. RECOMMENDED USE OF PORCELAIN TILES & PAVERS, Failure to comply with any of the below recommended uses will result in the Warranty provided herein becoming null and void.

RECOMMENDED USE FOR MATT FINISH PORCELAIN TILES (ALL COLLECTIONS)

These products are recommended for indoor floors, walls, countertops, and outdoor walls in commercial and residential application. The use of these products is not recommended for horizontal exterior surfaces that require anti-slip features. Caesar recommends an offset no greater than 30%, if a staggered pattern is required for tiles of 20" inches or longer.

RECOMMENDED USE FOR GRIP FINISH PORCELAIN TILES (ALL COLLECTIONS)

These products are recommended for indoor and outdoor floors and walls, in commercial and residential application, especially where antislip features are required. Caesar recommends an offset no greater than 30%, if a staggered pattern is required for tiles of 20" inches or longer.

RECOMMENDED USE FOR CHEVRON PORCELAIN TILES

These products are recommended for indoor floors, walls and outdoor walls in commercial and residential application. The use of these products is not recommended for horizontal exterior surfaces that require anti-slip features. Minimum grout joint recommended for Chevron in herringbones pattern installation is 4mm. No claim will be accepted for installations that fail to comply with such recommendation.

RECOMMENDED USE FOR 20 MM THICK PORCELAIN PAVERS (ALL COLLECTIONS)

These products are recommended for indoor floors, walls, countertops, and outdoor floor and walls in commercial and residential application. Caesar recommends an offset no greater than 30%, if a staggered pattern is required for tiles of 20" inches or longer.

COVE BASE AND BULLNOSE SHADE MATCHING WITH FIELD TILES

Regarding the use of Cove base (hereinafter referred to as "CB") and Bullnose (hereinafter referred to as "BN"), it is extremely important to understand the following:

- 1) CB and BN are special pieces intended for the wall basal use only and are meant to protect the wall from water, chemicals and dirt during the cleaning activities.
- 2) The main difference between BN and CB is that the second one is able to transition from the floor to the wall with a rounded connection edge that allows a better cleaning action in correspondence of the contact point between wall and floor. They both have a rounded miter cut on the upper side and not a straight cut. The rounded corner is meant to be the last ceramic bit before the plain wall (not covered by tiles) begins, and it is rounded for both esthetic reasons and easier cleaning.
- 3) Given the use for which they have been studied BN and CB are usually never toned in association with field tiles for two main reason:

- BN and CB are installed vertically, unlike the floor that is horizontal, and hence due to the different refraction of the light their tones will appear different anyways. Consequently, it has no relevance if the tone of the tile used on the floor and the tone of the BN and CB can be combined or not. Once installed, they will look as two different tones.

- the CB is made with different equipment and raw materials from the field tiles so that the shades are even more unlikely to match. The BN may have an easier combination as it is cut down directly from the field tile, but being used vertically the light refraction will still make them appear different.

4) Both the CB and BN are not designed to joint together ceramic covered floors and walls, and that is why the upper side is rounded and not straight. Caesar Ceramics recommends NOT to use the CB nor BN, wherever a ceramic covered wall is needed above them.

5) For the above said reasons Caesar Ceramics cannot be held responsible for problems related to the tone mismatching between the aforementioned BC and CB and the relative field tiles, for which an improper use becomes evident.

WARNING

Outdoor pavings installed unglued above the ground level are subject to the action of the wind, with the risk, in some cases, of becoming airborne.

The manufacturer recommends to require the assistance of a qualified professional in order to check the suitability of the installation system above the ground adopted, in accordance with the local laws and regulations and the conditions of use.

Failure to do so could result in serious injury or property damage.

A ceramic slab installed on a raised pedestal system may fracture on impact if a heavy object is dropped onto it from a height, with a risk of injury to anyone standing or walking on such slab.
